PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Business and Economics

Hosted at the University of Washington, this four week program provides students with on campus class-room instruction from experienced, qualified professors. Interactive lectures discuss unique business and economics concepts, the relationship between societal and business cultures, what innovation is and how to measure it, and the importance of entrepreneurial perspectives. This course is designed to encourage you to recognize cultural differences, develop critical thinking abilities, and explore international career opportunities. At the end of the program, students will compete in a group business case competition to put their new business skills to the test!

Contemporary History and Social Perspectives

Students will discuss the changing nature of society in America. Topics include the continual concentration of wealth within America's elite, the increasing cost of education, the rising burdens facing the middle class, the war on drugs, and an analysis of how each of these issues contributes to the weakening of upward mobility, otherwise known as the "American Dream".

Guest Lectures

The program includes a variety of professional guest speakers, showcasing a combination of traditional and modern day careers. Instructed by a diverse group of experienced professionals, you will explore various educational and career paths in order to gain perspective over the day to day lives of today's industry leaders.

Company Tours

You will be provided with private, interactive corporate office tours with local industry executives. Corporate visits are an unparalleled way for our students to meet with professionals from varying industries who can provide invaluable insight to American business culture, and help provide a real world context to concepts introduced in class. Students will attend 20 days of class throughout the program, learning from qualified, professional, and experienced instructors.



Students will live with a caring American families in the safety of a qualified Family Homestay.



Three meals each day - Students will be provided with breakfast and dinner with their homestay family on weekdays and lunch on campus where students can choose from the diverse eateries and restaurants. On weekends students are provided with all three meals with their homestay family.



Students will receive charter transportation to and from the airport. Students are also provided with public transportation passes allowing them to travel freely throughout the city.



Students will visit with varying professionals through company tours and faculty presentations. Professors and business executives will participate in open group discussions, answering any questions students may have regarding their profession, industry, or experiences.



Students will receive a personal smart phone. This device can be used throughout the program for unlimited local calls, text and data. Student phones will have contact information for our program hosts to ensure seamless communication throughout the program.



Once safely arrived, Experience America provides students with an extended orientation in order to ensure they feel comfortable in their new surroundings and confident interacting with local students.



We take pride in offering an inclusive experience, with fun, guided, and safe activities throughout our programs. These include city tours, sight-seeing tourist attractions, guided outdoor activities, and community volunteering.
